The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) requires Park volunteers to complete an agreement form in order to administer volunteer programs to comply with the following requirements:

- The organization will provide DCNR with names and social security numbers of the volunteers.
- Parental or guardian consent is required for volunteers under 18 years of age.
- When completed, a project will become the property of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.
- At the completion of a project, but no later than the end of each three-month period, the volunteer (individual, family, or organization) will provide an updated list of the volunteers and the hours and dates worked.
- Conservation Volunteers shall be treated as employees of the Commonwealth for purposes of automotive and general liability. In addition, volunteers are covered by worker's compensation.
- The Conservation Volunteer is authorized to operate a Commonwealth motor vehicle, when required, provided the individual possesses a valid Pennsylvania Driver's License.
- Either party may cancel the agreement at any time.
